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RECORD BALEARIC DEBT

● Local government owes banks a record **6,633 million euros.**

Palma.—The Balearic government debt mountain stands at 6.633 million euros, almost a fifth of the total British defence budget. And the borrowing continues and

the mountain continues to grow. Last year the government was forced to borrow an additional 857 million euros. In the two years that Balearic leader

Jose Ramon Bauza has been in power government borrowing has increased by 2,000 million euros. Bauza has promised to reduce the debt but so far he has been unsuccessful.
