Good economic news for Britain and Spain

Madrid.—Britain got a double boost yesterday as its recovery from recession gathered momentum and the International Monetary Fund raised the country's growth forecasts more than for any other major economy.

Factories expanded production far more quickly than expected in February. For the second time in six months, the Fund sharply raised its forecasts for Brit-

ish growth, which it now sees hitting 2.9 percent in 2014 before easing to 2.5 percent next year. That was up from previous forecasts of 2.4 and 2.2 percent. The IMF also raised its growth forecasts for the Spanish economy this year from 0.6% to 0.9%. That brings the figures more in line with predictions made recently by the European Commission and the Spanish government. **See Business**
