first time we felt very unsafe...”

● “We watched many young tourists being robbed, and when my wife warned two young lads of what was about to happen she was slapped by one of these criminals...”

MUCH has been written about the problem of thieves masquerading as prostitutes in Magalluf but today we publish an eyewitness account from a British couple who will not return to Magalluf because they feel unsafe.

Unfortunately, this letter will not come as a surprise to anyone involved in tourism in Magalluf. We published the letter on our facebook site yesterday afternoon and the response was enormous. But everyone agreed; something has to be done about the security problem in Magalluf.

The last thing that Majorca needs at the moment is for British tourists to say that they will not be visiting our resorts because they fear for their safety.
