# NEXT STOP BENIDORM FOR BRITISH POLICE

**B**RITISH police look set to continue patrolling resorts across the country helping their Spanish counterparts. Two British police officers were sent to the Balearics earlier this month helping to patrol both Magalluf and San Antonio in Ibiza. And now British officers look set to be sent to Benidorm on the mainland and to other

holiday destinations. The local authorities on the island welcomed the two British officers who spent a week in Magalluf and then a further seven days in Ibiza. Local police chiefs want as much co-operation with their counterparts in northern Europe as possible because of the massive influx of tourists during the summer months.
