Cameron visits areas hit by devastating floods



**LONDON.** Prime Minister David Cameron yesterday visited northwest England where two people have died and hundreds of others have been forced to leave homes flooded by record heavy rainfall. With more than a month's rain falling over 24 hours in some areas, swathes of northern England and Scotland are under water, prompting the government to call on the army to help evacuate those trapped in their homes.
