WARNING OVER WATER



Drought fears for this summer.

Palma.—The President of the Balearic government Francina Armengol warned this morning that they couldn't guarantee a water supply to all homes, busi-

nesses and hotels this summer because of the severe drought this winter. Armengol said that they were deeply concerned at the water situation after one of

the driest winters on record. Many local councils have already introduced water saving schemes and others are desperately trying to plug leaks in the water net-

work. The Balearic President said that her government were monitoring the situation.
