One person treated for burns as llaüt sinks off Andratx



PALMA. One person suffered minor burns yesterday when there was a fire on a "llaüt" near to Puerto Andratx. Three people were on board the boat when the incident occurred around eight in the morning. They had been transferred to another boat by the time

the Puerto Portals marine rescue boat arrived. Despite attempts to put the fire out, the eight-metre-long llaüt sank. Emergency health personnel took one of the three to Palma for treatment to the burns. Fire crews also attended the scene but were not needed.
