Spain's PM says Brexit talks with Britain will be as part of the EU

ANY negotiations between Spain and Britain over Britons' exit from the European Union will be done as part of the EU bloc of 27 countries, prime minister Mariano Rajoy said yesterday.

Asked at a news conference whether Spain had any conditions going into Brexit talks next year, Rajoy said: "The only red line is that we

are 27, we need to negotiate all together and we will negotiate a common position as the EU."

Extricating Britain from the EU opens up several thorny fronts with Spain, which said shortly after the 23 June referendum that it would seek joint sovereignty of Gibraltar, a British territory on its southern coast.

The Spanish government, which faces a

separatist challenge in the northeastern Catalonia region, has also sought to quash suggestions by Scotland it could seek a different deal with the EU from the rest of Britain.

Spain is also home to the largest population of British people living

abroad in the European Union, many of them pensioners who have retired to coastal resorts.

British police say George Michael autopsy “inconclusive”, more tests needed

THE cause of singer George Michael's death this week is unclear after an initial autopsy and more tests are needed, British police said yesterday.

British singer Michael, who became one of the pop idols of the 1980s with Wham! and then forged a career as a successful solo artist, died at his home in southern England on Sunday. He was 53.

"A post mortem examination was carried out yesterday as part of the investigation into the death of George Michael," Thames Valley police said.

"The cause of death is inconclusive and further tests will now be carried out. The results of these tests are unlikely to be known for several weeks," they added in a statement.

British police had said that Michael's death was "unexplained but not suspicious". Michael's manager, Michael Lippman, said he had died of heart failure.

In the mid-1980s, "Wham! were one of the most successful pop duos with singles such as *Wake Me Up Before You Go-Go*, *Careless Whisper*, *Last Christmas* and *The Edge of Heaven*
