Record Saturday at Palma airport

- Busiest first six months of the year ever at Palma airport.
- Tensions between taxi drivers and pirate operators have calmed.

● Arrivals at Palma airport were the highest that they have ever been in the first six months of the year. There were 159,995 arrivals on 846 flights, figures more typical of July and August than May. Today, over 140,000 people on 772 flights are expected.

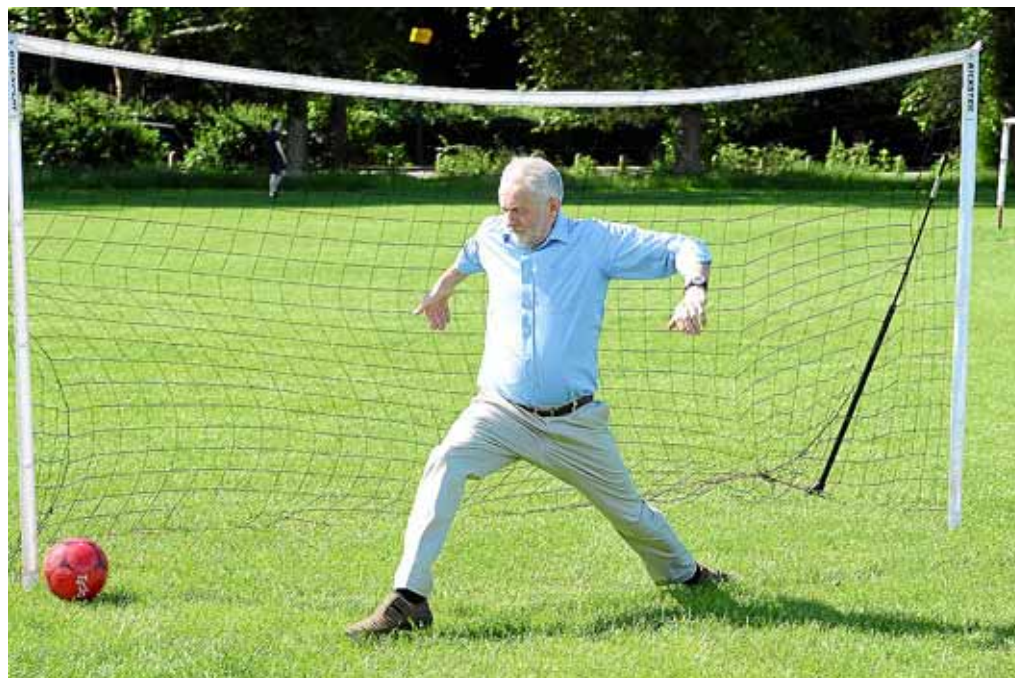
The numbers being registered suggest that the airport will have another record summer, with more passengers than last year.

Meanwhile, there were no real issues with taxi drivers, things having mostly settled down since Thursday night's protest stoppage.

A few drivers did, though, try to impede the operations of others.

And, the problems British Airways suffered with their IT programmes at Heathrow and Gatwick had little if no effect on operations at Palma airport.

Another Bank Holiday in the UK has boosted traffic through the airport as the start of peak season draws for ever nearer with some hotels already reporting 100% percent occupancy in the main resorts. **See inside**

● Jeremy Corbyn used FA Cup Final day to launch plans to offer football fans a "flexible football ticket" to help more people attend matches. The proposal would mean fans aren't left with unusable tickets after matches are moved or rescheduled. The Labour leader, a Gunner - was at Wembley to support Arsenal - also pledging more money for grassroots football if Labour wins power.
