MI5 internal review

● Britain's MI5 has begun an internal review of how it handled intelligence on Manchester suicide bomber Salman Abedi, who was known to the authorities but not under active investigation, a source told *Reuters* yesterday. Interior minister Amber Rudd said the review was the “right first step” for the intelligence agency to take in the wake of the 22 May bombing that killed 22 people at a pop concert by U.S. singer Ariana Grande. **See Inside.**
