## BALEARIC GOVERNMENT MAY SANCTION RYANAIR



**PALMA.** The Balearic government's consumer affairs department and the ports and airports directorate have opened a case file into Ryanair flight cancellations. They will be seeking first-hand information from the airline to explain the cancellation of 52 Balearic flights over the next six weeks and will then determine if some sanctions against the airline will be justified.

Contact has been made

with Ryanair and a meeting has been requested.

According to the ports and airports directorate, there will be 14 return journey cancellations between Ibiza and Frankfurt and twelve between Ibiza and Barcelona.

Fourteen return flights between Mahon and Barcelona are being cancelled, as are twelve between Palma and East Midlands. More than 5,000 passengers will be affected.
