THOMSON Holidays, which helped pioneer package tourism to Majorca, was rebranded as TUI UK yesterday in a rebranding move. TUI UK and Ireland managing director Nick Longman said he hopes the move will boost sales as the firm expands its range of holidays from traditional bucket and spade breaks.

He said: "Thomson is a great heritage brand with rich nostalgia and that's fantastic, we've all had great Thomson holidays over the years, but it can also be a bit limiting." The company also announced yesterday it was operating extra flights to make up for capacity lost after this month's collapse of Monarch.
