London.—A military dog who helped save the lives of troops in Afghanistan has received the prestigious PDSA Dickin Medal for his bravery.

Mali, a Belgian Malinois, was recognised for his heroic actions during a highly sensitive military operation in 2012, where he assisted an assault force in securing a key enemy stronghold.

He was yesterday presented the medal—which is the animal equivalent of the Victoria Cross.
