Best of British powers fleet of new aircraft for Palma-based airline

PALMA based airline, Air Europa, unveiled its first Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner aircraft which will be used on long haul flights. The aircraft are powered by Rolls Royce Trent engines. All 14 new Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner aircraft will be powered by the British built engine. Mark Harrison, Rolls-Royce, Vice President said: "We are delighted that Air Europa has once again selected the Trent 1000 and continues to recognise the benefits that this engine brings, delivering excellent lifetime fuel burn and reliability on the aircraft as well as outstanding emissions and noise performance."
