Women charged with violent assault on a Manacor 80-year-old woman



PALMA. Three women have been detained by the National Police and charged with robbery with violence as the consequence of an assault on an 80-year-old woman.

On Sunday, 22 April, the elderly woman returned to her home and encountered four female intruders.

She was dragged out of the property and thrown onto the street violently.

This caused her to fall and hit her head, which provoked bleeding from a wound.

She was rushed to Manacor Hospital, where National Police officers based in Manacor gathered details of what had happened.

Investigations led to the arrest of two women in Palma and a third in Manacor. The police say that the women are part of a gang with more than 175 arrests and investigations, most of them for crimes against property.

Further arrests are expected, in particular that of the fourth woman involved in the incident on 22 April.
