TWO TOURISTS INJURED AFTER BEING HIT BY A BOAT

TWO German tourists were in a critical condition in hospital yesterday after being hit by a boat in the waters off the Es Trenc beach on Friday evening. The crew of the vessel came to the rescue of the two swimmers, who were be-

lieved to be using a mini-submersible device. They were both rushed to hospital where they remain in a serious condition in Palma. Police have launched a full investigation to establish the exact cause of the incident.
