## Hundreds of flights hit by Ryanair strike

● At least 24 flights to and from Palma airport were cancelled yesterday and many others delayed due to strike action by Ryanair pilots across Europe.

Pilots staged their first simultaneous strike yesterday as they ramped up a battle for better pay and conditions, plunging tens of thousands of passengers into travel chaos during the busy summer season. The Irish no-frills airline was forced to scrap some 400 out of 2,400 scheduled European flights as pilots in Ireland, Germany, Belgium, Sweden and the Netherlands walked off the job.
