● Simon Manley, British ambassador to Spain: “Under the current rules, UK nationals living in Spain must register with the Spanish authorities (at the Oficina de Extranjeros or at a designated local police station) to be legally resident here. Therefore, I and the team strongly recommend you ensure you are correctly registered as a resident, as is your current obligation.” **See Letter on Page Two.**

## Sterling jumps after EU court aide says Britain can drop Brexit

*London.*—Sterling jumped yesterday after a senior European Union legal adviser said Britain could unilaterally withdraw its Brexit notice, easing concern among investors about Britain crashing out of the bloc in March without a deal. The advice from a European Court

of Justice advocate general is non-binding but the prospect of a route out of the Brexit process cheered the market, even as Prime Minister Theresa May pressed ahead with plans for a parliamentary debate on her divorce deal with the EU.
