Spain set to publish no-deal Brexit advice



300,000 British citizens live in Spain and 116,000 Spaniards live in Britain.

Madrid.—The Spanish government is to publish contingency plans for a no-deal Brexit in January, focusing on aviation, citizens' rights and banks, Spanish daily *El Pais* reported.

Spanish airline Iberia is part of British aviation group

IAG, while one of Spain's top banks, Santander, has branches all over the UK, leaving them vulnerable to fall-out. Some 300,000 British citizens reside in Spain, while 116,000 Spaniards live in the UK. There is concern across the country, both amongst British expats and the

Spanish authorities how a no-deal Brexit will hit the country. The British ambassador to Spain, Simon Manley, has urged British citizens living in Spain to register with the Spanish authorities and basically get their paper-work in order.
