Spain's Supreme Court sentences "Wolf Pack" to fifteen years in prison for rape

Madrid.—Spain's Supreme Court yesterday sentenced five men accused of attacking a woman in Pamplona in 2016 to 15 years in prison each for rape, overturning a previous sentence which had convicted the men of a lesser charge of sexual assault.

One of the men was sentenced to an addi-

tional two years in jail for stealing the victim's phone.

The ruling comes after an appeal from the victim and the men, who called themselves the "Wolf Pack", against the original sentence passed by a local court in Navarra, which had been met by wide-spread protests. **See inside**
