BALEARIC CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT TARGETS MASS TOURISM



● Francina Armengol told the Balearic parliament yesterday that she will be promoting “a strategy that places a limit on tourism of excesses and a ceiling that will be socially and economically sustainable” for cruise ships. Armengol stressed the need to offset the “inherent inconveniences” of the arrival of millions of people each year and to define a model for cruise tourism that fits in with Balearic objectives.
