Six arrests following Palma bar brawl



PALMA. On Tuesday at quarter to six in the morning, there was a fight in a bar in Palma's Calle Manacor which has now resulted in the arrests of six people.

The National Police report that it took until Thursday to identify all those involved - five men and one woman of differing nationalities.

The fight had seemingly broken out between two Moroccans; the reason was

jealousy. Glasses and bottles were thrown and used, and two people who were injured had to be taken to hospital.

The police found them near to the bar with cuts and bruises to different parts of their bodies.

The homicide squad is in charge of the investigation. The final one of the six to be arrested was detained yesterday afternoon.
