### BOMB ON BEACH

*Barcelona.*— Spanish navy specialists yesterday detonated an old explosive device dating back to the Spanish Civil War that had been found underwater just off one of Barcelona’s most popular beaches, police said.

The beach remained closed to the public yesterday, having been evacuated on Sunday afternoon after an off-duty police officer discovered the unexploded cannon projectile 25 metres (80 feet) from shore.

The shell, thought to date back to the 1936-1939 Spanish Civil War and contains 70kg (154 lb) of the explosive TNT, was moved with floating devices one nautical mile out to sea and to a depth of some 40 metres (130 ft), where it was successfully detonated, police said.
