CHRISTMAS BEACH This winter will be warmer than usual WEATHER

Palma.—It's going to be warmer than usual this winter according to the State Meteorological Agency, AEMET.

"The average temperature of the quarter is 11 degrees, the winter of 2020 will be above that," says María José Guerrero.

The rain is never far away and Aemet is predicting 129 litres per square metre of rainfall, which is about average for this time of year.

There will be a mixture of clear days with frost and dew and occasional foggy mornings and colder days with sleet and strong winds.

Christmas will be dry, sunny and mild with a top temperature of 18 to 20 degrees during the day dropping to around 7 overnight, but the rain will return just before New Year with around 28 litres per square metre expected on December 28th.
