Washington.— A U.S. air strike in Baghdad that killed a top Iranian commander aimed to disrupt an “imminent attack” that would have endangered Americans in the Middle East, U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo said in television interviews yesterday.

Pompeo, in interviews on Fox News and CNN, declined to discuss many details of the alleged threat but said it was “an intelligence-based assessment” that drove the U.S. decision to target Qassem Soleimani, the commander of Iran’s elite Quds Force.
