Palma.—Tourists arriving for their holiday in Magalluf, the Playa de Palma and San Antonio this summer in Ibiza could be asked to sign a "good behaviour form" in which they promise to abide by the hotel rules and also that they are aware of the new Balearic government legislation which limits booze on all inclusive holiday packages, which outlaws the

holiday packages, which outlaws the so-called "balconying" and antisocial behaviour.

The move is a new twist in the crackdown on antisocial behaviour and is aimed at shielding hotels



from a wave of compensation claims from tourists. Hotels will be fined by the local ministry for tourism if they fail to abide by strict rulings which will be introduced this summer. Tourists in the three resorts (Magalluf, Playa de Palma, and San

Antonio) will only be allowed six free alcoholic drinks in their all inclusive holiday package. The local ministry will also be targeting bars and shops which sell alcohol.

Palma and Magalluf will be asked to sign a "good conduct form" in which they promise to behave and also that they are aware of the new government legislation which limits all inclusive booze packages and crackdown on anti-social behaviour.
