Spanish coronavirus cases overtake China

- Spain overtook China's total number of coronavirus cases yesterday but business leaders and regional authorities criticised the government's decision to further restrict the movement of people and keep non-essential workers at home until mid-April.
- Four more patients have died from coronavirus in the Balearic Islands, bringing the total number of fatalities to 37, according to the Ministry of Health.
- Some 12,298 health workers have tested



positive for coronavirus in Spain, deputy health emergency chief Maria Jose Sierra said at a news conference yesterday. That is equivalent to around 14% of the country's 85,195 cases, roughly the same proportion as last week.

Britain's EasyJet has grounded its fleet of 344 planes and has no clear idea when it might resume flights, the company said yesterday, in another sign of the strain on airlines battling to survive the coronavirus pandemic. **Inside**
