# 4.25 billion-euro Spanish tourism bailout



● Prime Minister Sánchez yesterday announced the government's tourism industry stimulus plan. With a budget of 4,262 million euros, there are five main aspects to this plan. One of these is that all destinations in the country will be presented as Covid-safe and will have an emblem to show this.

● But Hostelry Association said they weren't satisfied with the announcement because, among other reasons, it didn't include tourism vouchers to encourage Spaniards to spend on restaurants and hotels in their own country.

● The Exceltur alliance for tourism excellence said that the aid programme doesn't deal with essential measures for the short term.
