## Nadal fans rock

here might have been only 5,000 fans present on Court Philippe Chatrier due to COVID-19 restrictions but rarely has there been such an electrifying and raucous atmosphere at Roland Garros as Novak Djokovic beat Rafael Nadal in what will go down as one of the most memorable matches contested at the French Open.

With an 11pm curfew looming on Friday, a vocal crowd chanted 'we will not leave' as it seemed they would be ejected from the grounds when the riveting Nadal-Djokovic semi-final spilled into a fourth set.

## Majority

When the stadium's PA, Marc Maury, started to make an announcement, the majority of the crowd booed loudly to drown out his voice as they presumed that they were being ordered to vacate the court, while some spectators started to make their way towards the exit.

However, Maury had to repeat the announcement twice - "in agreement with authorities, the match will be completed in your presence" -- and once he had made himself heard, the jeers turned into screams of delight.



Palma.—The Balearic Government paid an average of 2.14 euros for each Covid face mask it has bought over the last 15 months.

In the first months of the pandemic, governments shelled out huge amounts of money for PPE equipment for health workers on the frontline and some media outlets in Spain

claimed that the Government was paying up to eight euros for each mask.

The Balearic Government was forced to regulate the price of face masks for the public, which was set at a maximum price of 0.96 cents in April, then reduced to 0.72 cents in October.

The Balearic Government has bought surgical, FFP2 and FFP3 masks. The surgical ones proved to be the most popular and the FFP3s were the least popular.


The average prices paid for health and social care professionals' FFP2 and FFP3 masks have been 0.85 cents and 0.50 cents respectively.
