VACCINATION FOR STUDENTS STUDYING ABROAD

● Today and tomorrow, there will be vaccination of students in the Balearics who are due to study abroad from the start of the coming academic year.

The health ministry aims to complete their vaccination schedule before the end of the month.

They will be given the Pfizer vaccine, which requires a three-week gap be-

tween doses. Appointments will not be needed.

Vaccination will be at the main centres on the islands.

Students will, however, need to show proof that they will be studying abroad, e.g. for the Erasmus 2021 programme.

Minors will have to be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
