“IT IS YOUR LEGAL REQUIREMENT TO DEMAND THE COVID PASSPORT...”

● Balearic government’s blunt message to bars and restaurants as new legislation comes into force today. Businesses can be fined for not asking for the Covid passport.

Palma.—The Balearic government warned bar and restaurant owners yesterday that they had a legal requirement to ask their clients for the Covid passport today as new legislation comes into force.

Owners of bars and restaurants

who have a capacity of more than 50 people from today must ask their clients for the passport.

The government said yesterday that 83 percent of the population had now had both jabs and they called on those who were still unvaccinated to do so as quickly as

possible. The government said that their inspectors and police officers would be on duty to ensure that the new legislation was being acted on.

The move is controversial and already there have been protests. Critics claim that people no

longer have the option of being vaccinated or not.

Over recent weeks the number of Covid cases has risen significantly and there is a concern that the figures will rise even further next week as a result of the two public holidays.
