# SPEAKING THE LANGUAGE OF LOVE IN SPAIN

Palma/London.—*The Language of Love* sees a group of Britons and a group of Spaniards pairing up at a Spanish country estate to see if they can find romance... despite not speaking each other's language.

Set in a stunning finca in Andalusia, host Davina McCall is joined by Majorcan TV host, actor and singer Ricky Merino, who will be on hand to interpret how the couples' relationships are developing.

The group of Britons seeking romance will travel to Spain where they'll meet their potential partners – a group of Spanish speakers also looking for their own 'historia de amor' – to test whether love is deeper than just words.

The newly formed couples will take part in challenges and tasks to help them test their connection as well as learning more about each other's countries, their culture and their languages.
