Spain economy to grow more this year

Madrid.—Spain's economy is likely to grow around 1.6% in 2023, 0.3 percentage points more than previously estimated, mostly due to a stronger-than-expected expansion last year, Bank of Spain chief economist Angel Gavilan says.

Gross domestic product grew a fasterthan-expected 5.5% in 2022 as the country avoided a recession in the final quarter amid a global slowdown.

Spain's National Statistics Institute has revised significantly upwards the initial growth estimates for the first two quarters of last year, while the economy grew 0.2% in the fourth quarter from the previous

quarter, above 0.1% expected by the central bank.

"Mechanically, this new information would prompt an upward revision in the GDP growth rate in 2023 by about 0.3 percentage points," Gavilan said in a presentation posted on the Bank of Spain's web

On Monday, the European Commission revised its growth projections for Spain to 1.4% for 2023 from 1%.

For the first quarter of 2023, Gavilan also sees a higher-than-expected growth rate at least similar to the fourth quarter of last
