Spain PM off to China

● Spanish Prime Minister Pedro Sanchez will visit China next week following a formal invitation by President Xi Jinping, as the Asian country seeks to position itself as a mediator in the ongoing war in Ukraine. The invitation, first reported by newspaper *El Pais* on Wednesday, was later confirmed by Minister for the Presidency Felix Bolaños in an interview with radio station Cadena Ser. “The trip will take place next week.”

Palma.— The Bulletin has received yet another report of a carjacking involving vehicles coming off the Palma to Barcelona ferry in Barcelona. This is the story of the latest victims.

“Three weeks ago we took our car on the ferry from Alcudia to Barcelona heading for Andorra. Nice big black SUV with Swedish registered plates and ski rack on top. Family inside - Easy catch.

“One of our rear tyres was “knifed” by someone on the ferry car deck just before our arrival in Barcelona. Partners in crime were waiting at the dockside ready to follow. We drove off the ferry and up on the highway. Five minutes later a tyre low pressure warning came on. We left the high-

way and parked at a petrol station to address the problem. The rest of the story unfolded exactly as for the British couple in your recent article. (Items stolen from the vehicle). When we realised what had happened we were just too tired of the whole ordeal and had no interest in hours of filing a report at some police station. We did however later contact the ferry company to let them know what had happened on their watch. No reply from the ferry company yet.

“We will never set our feet on a Barcelona ferry again and never ever travel through Barcelona. After our week in Andorra we arranged for a couple of guys to take the car back to Mallorca. We flew back.”
