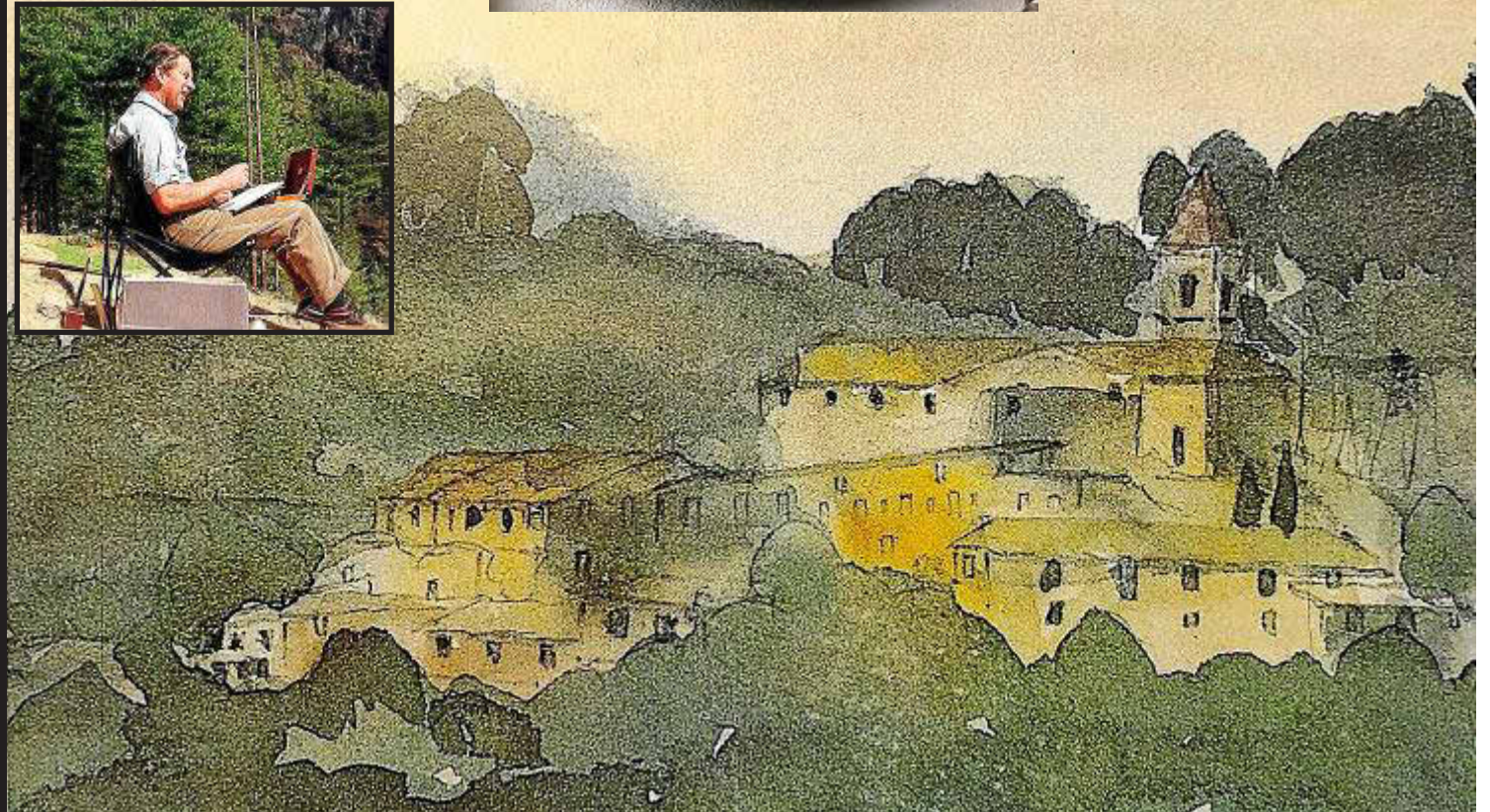
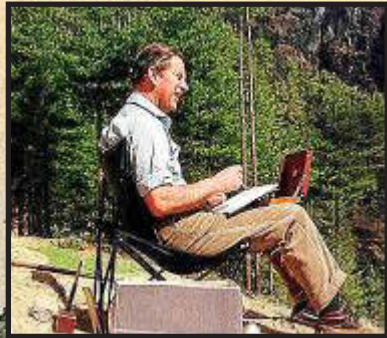

King Charles paints Mallorca

KING Charles enjoyed painting in Mallorca and at least three of his works from Mallorca are included in the book, *HRH The Prince of Wales Watercolours*. Among places on the island which he has painted are Valldemossa and Andratx. King Charles always used sketch-books made especially for him in England: sheets of absorbent paper in landscape format in a sturdy brown linen cover. The pictures are surprisingly small: 8.8 to 24 cm high and 9.5 to 29 cm wide. He painted extensively on the island during a holiday in 1988 when he stayed at the Marivent Palace.

MALLORCA CORONATION CRISIS!

● Island runs out of bunting, and satellite engineers are rushed off their feet.

Palma.—Mallorca has sold out of coronation bunting as hundreds of British residents and tourists prepare to mark the coronation of King Charles. At Nice Price in Portals the *Bulletin* was informed that they had sold out last week.

Meanwhile, satellite engineers have been rushed off their feet, with scores of people asking for British TV stations to be installed on their televisions so that they do not miss any details of the big event tomorrow. A whole series of par-
