The attack took place four weeks ago and comes after an Italian tourist was also bitten in Playa de Palma earlier this week. The local authorities closed the beach in Playa de Palma and issued a full alert. Initially it was thought that it could have been a shark but later the local authorities said that it was a 10

centimetre long anchovy. Annette told the *Bulletin* that she was swimming with a group of people but she was the only one who was bitten. "They must have liked my elderly skin," she joked. The other known victim, the Italian tourist, is aged 85. "I can't wait to go back into the water," said the Son Caliu resident. "It is a nightmare being stuck at home in the summer."
