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PRIVATE JET MALLORCA

Palma.—In July, there were 2,088 private jet arrivals and departures at Palma Airport. These represented around 6.5% of flights registered by the AENA airports authority - 32,198.

AENA doesn't publish official details of private jets, so the information comes from WINGX, a firm specialising in aviation activity analysis and intelligence.

For June and July combined, there were 4,020 flights, a slight decrease on the same two months of 2025 when there were 4,181.

Up to August 24, WINGX recorded 1,513 flights, up some seven per cent on August 2025.

Palma ranks eleventh among European airports for private jet flights. The list is headed by Paris-Le Bourget Airport, followed by Nice in second place. Palma's position reflects the fact that business jet traffic intensifies in the summer months as does the arrival of tourists in the luxury sector. Private jets have been a target for critics of Mallorca's tourism model, environmentalists GOB having been among those calling for a ban.

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ANTI-TOURISM 7 charged over protest

● Seven people face initial charges of public disorder and damage to property related to the disturbances at the end of the anti-tourism demonstration in Palma on July 26.

The National Police have submitted a report to the court investigating what happened on the night. The seven will have to appear before the court. The police maintain that their response was to violence instigated by some of the demonstrators. Officers were subjected to a barrage of stones, cans and poles.

Highlighted in the report is the particularly tense situation that arose in the final stage of the protest.
